### 15th Annual Meeting

Fifteen years is a long time! It seems like only last month or last year that Pastor E. L. Bynum, Dr. David Otis Fuller, and Dr. D. A. Waite sat down together to consider the founding of a new organization which later became known as "THE DEAN BURGON SOCIETY." Finally, November 3 and 4, 1978, arrived, and we had our first organizational meeting.

### Only Two Still Active

As I look at the faces of those who attended that first organizational meeting, I have many different thoughts. Some have gone home to be with the Lord. ## Dorms At The School

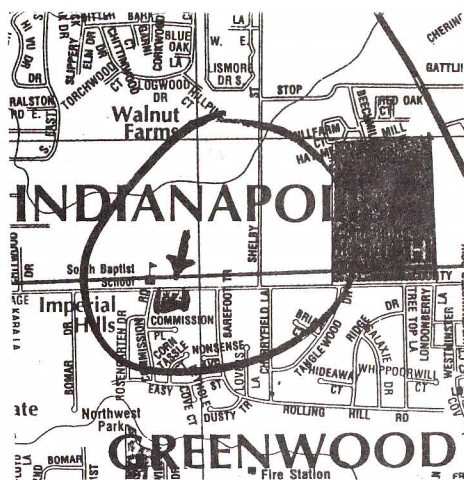

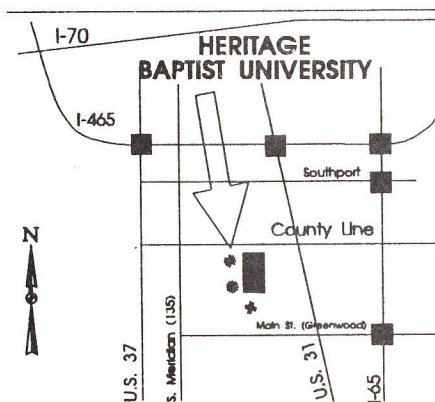
## Get A Magnifier

## Three Stations Want Us

We have three stations that we have had to cancel due to lack of funds. ## Present Station Totals

As you can see from the above radio station log, we have a total of FIVE stations that are carrying our 30 minute weekly program and ELEVEN carrying our 5 minute daily program.

## Present Radio Topics

At present, on the weekly 30 minute broadcast, we are answering Dr. Stuart Custer's booklet about the "KJV Controversy." I have written a 200-page answer to it, and I am using this as a basis for the programs. We take up 60 questions about the booklet, and give answers to each of these questions that are raised by Dr.

Custer. The ANSWER TO DR. CUSTER ON THE T.R. AND KJB is #1251 for a GIFT to DBS of \$20.00. On the 5 minute broadcast, I am reading our new book, DEFENDING THE KING JAMES BIBLE and commenting on it as we go. This book is #1594-P for a GIFT to DBS of \$12.00.
